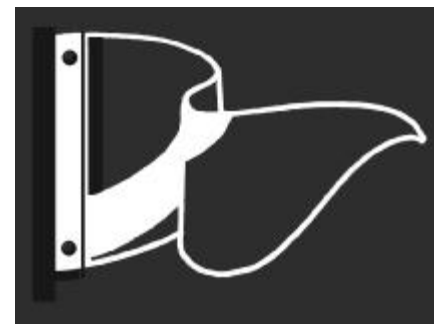

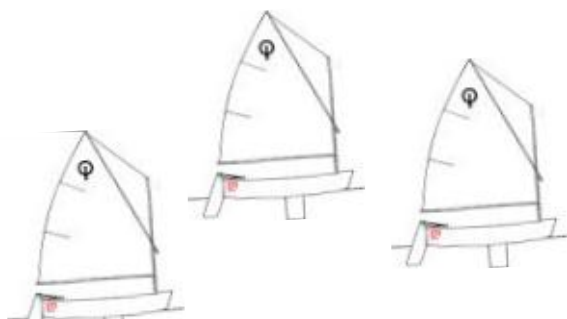
Donations to the Sailing Program:
